Social Science Week 2023 - international Year of Millets

The Food and Agriculture Organization (FAO) and United Nations (UN) has recognised 2023 as International Year of Millets or IYM2023 for awareness about health and nutritional benefits of millets. The Indian Government proposed to celebrate 2023 as International Year of Millets. Millets can play an important role and contribute to our collective efforts to empower smallholder farmers, achieve sustainable development, eliminate hunger, adapt to climate change, promote biodiversity, and transform agrifood systems.

Millet, a grain mainly grown and consumed in developing countries until recently and once considered a poor man's staple, is quickly becoming a favourite globally among those affected by climate change because of its ability to thrive in harsh and arid environments. Its drought-resistant quality makes it attractive as many parts of the world begin to experience a water supply shortage. Because millets use less water to produce and grow in less time, it can be an alternative to imported cereals. Millets also have high nutritional values.

In addition to millet's attractive growth characteristics, it is one of the most nutritious and anti-allergenic grains available. Millet is gluten-free, making it an excellent choice for the millions of people around the world who suffer from Celiac disease or have a gluten sensitivity. It is high in vitamin B, calcium, iron, potassium, zinc, magnesium, and fats. And it is an excellent source of protein and dietary fibre. Millet production is projected to sharply increase due to its many health benefits and ability to grow in a variety of climates. Now that 97 percent of actively publishing climate scientists agree climate change is real, countries and organizations are beginning to take more meaningful steps to ensure their food supply can withstand the changing environment. Millets can play a key role in achieving that objective, and it is hoped that by declaring 2023 as the International Year of Millets, more attention will be paid to this important grain.
