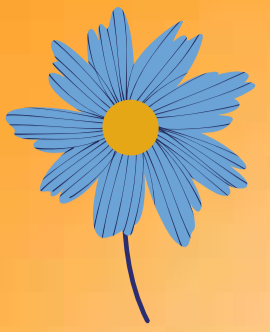

it's beautiful & so are you"*

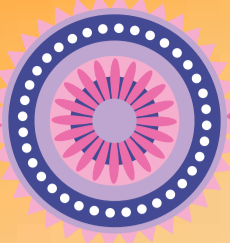


In order to emphasize the importance of Blue colour, the Blue Day was celebrated by Pre-primary students.

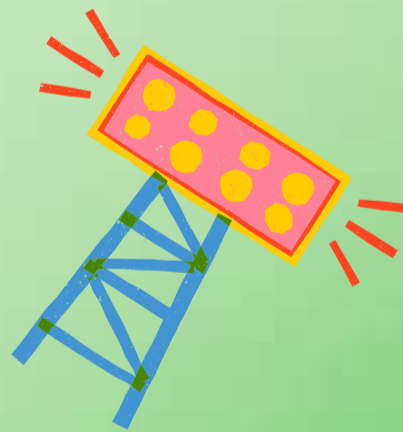
