Visit to Sumandeep Vidhyapeeth

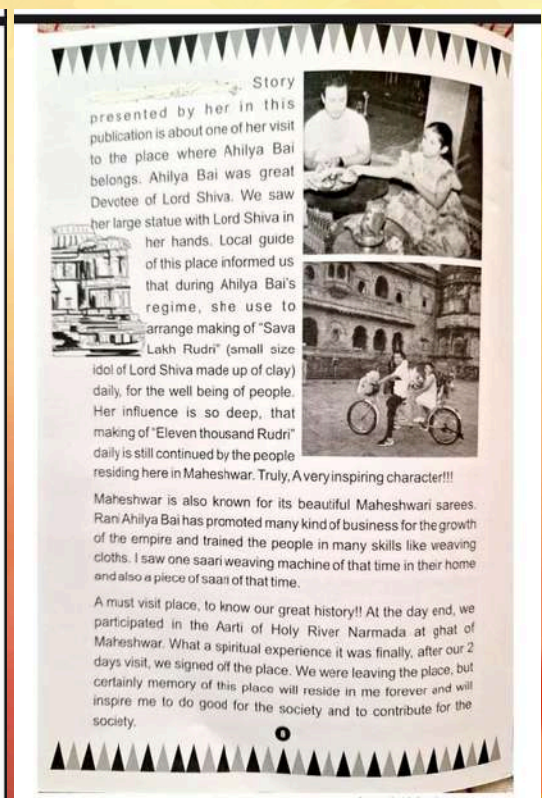
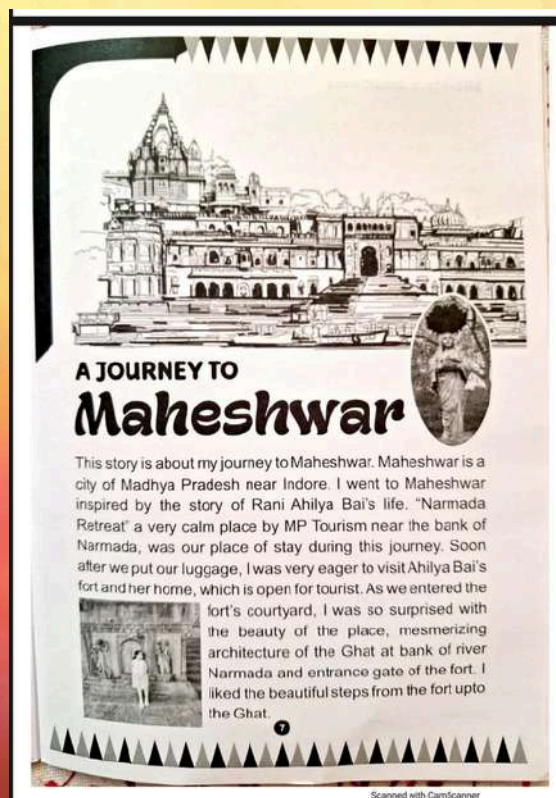
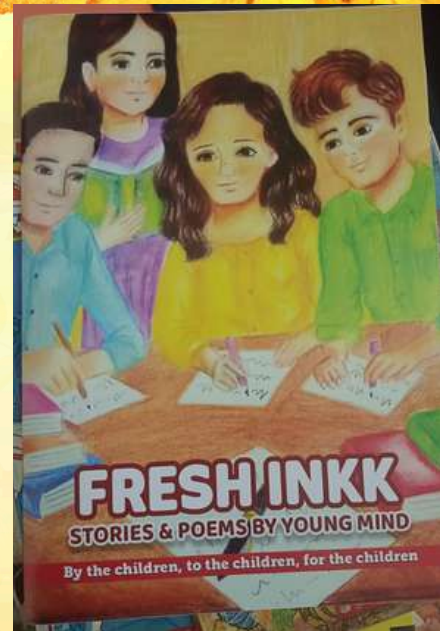
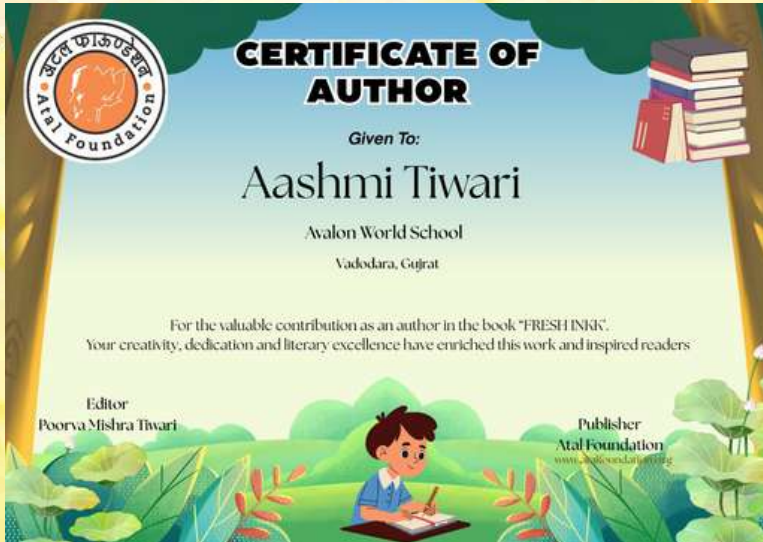
23 September 2025
