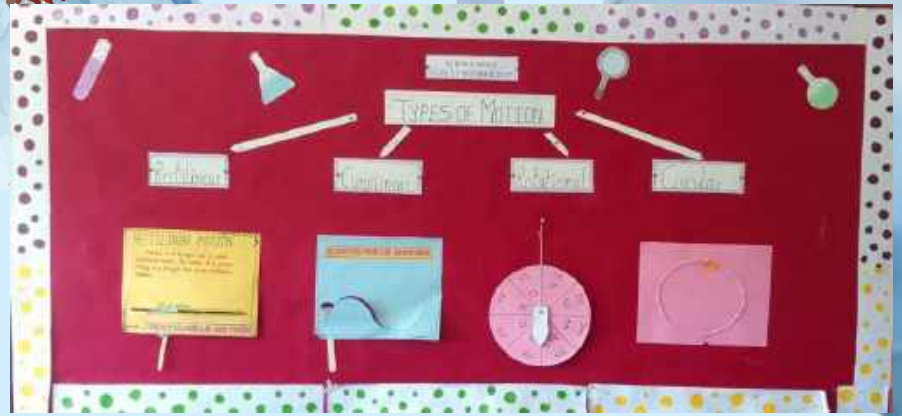


Science Week

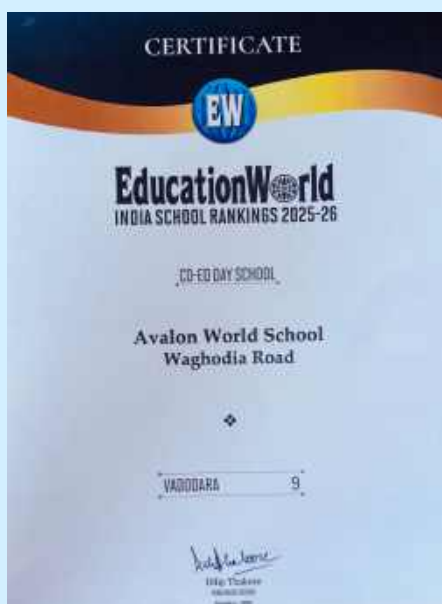




Another feather in AWSW's Cap
