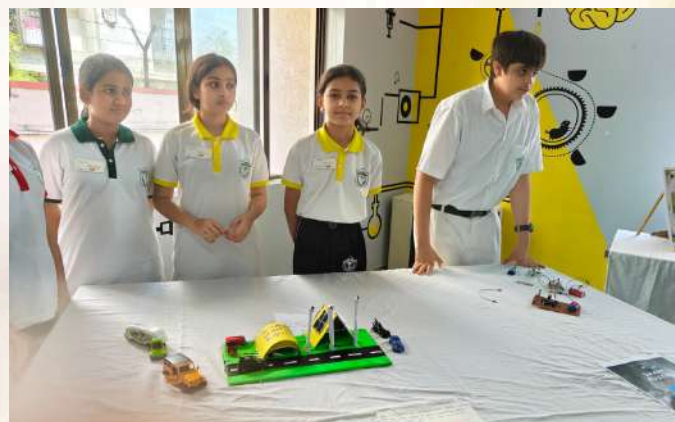
Atal Tinkering lab Exhibition -DPS Harni

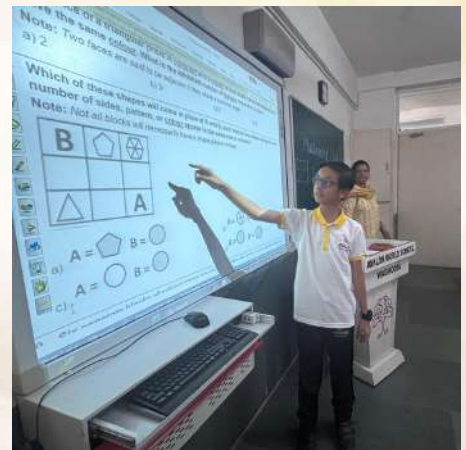

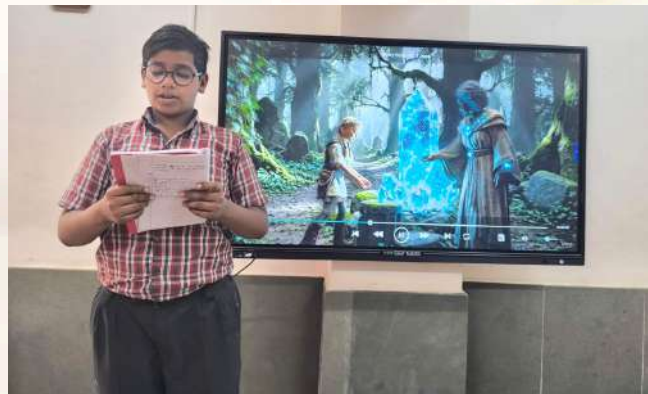
