इन्हीं से महके जीवन हमारा।

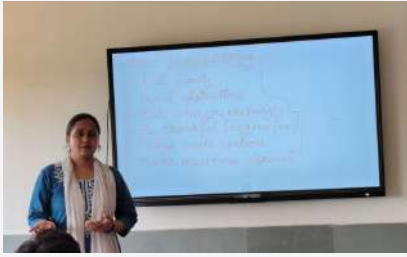

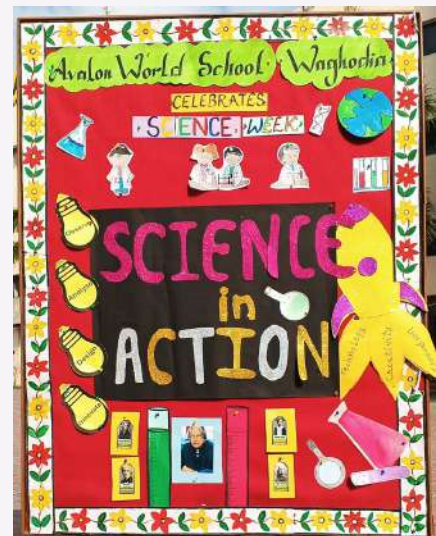

15-06-2026

Smart Clicks, Safe Cyberspace

In today's time, when the internet has become an essential part of our lives, the risk of cyber threats has also grown. From online learning and digital payment to social media and cloud storage, technology makes our lives easier and faster. So nowadays, cybersecurity is more important than ever. Cybersecurity refers to protecting all communicable devices from unauthorised access, attack or damage. Cybercriminals use various methods to gain access to sensitive information, such as bank details.

A strong cybersecurity system helps to protect personal and financial data. Here are simple steps to stay cyber-safe:

- **Strong Passwords:** Create a unique password combination of letters, numbers, and symbols. Avoid using dates like birthdates or anniversaries. 81% of hacking-related breaches exploit weak or stolen passwords.
- **MFA:** Enable Multi-factor authentication to add an extra layer of security. Add biometrics like fingerprint scanning, facial or voice recognition, or iris scanning to your device.
- **Avoid opening suspicious links or attachments from unknown sources.** Verify the URL of the webpage with a padlock symbol  https://. Some phishing websites are www.gmail.com , www.icic6ank.com, www.bankofindia.com.
- **Never share passwords and OTPs online.** Approximately 90% of data breaches involve human error, such as falling for scams by sharing passwords.
- **Cybersecurity experts advise against making a habit of changing your passwords on a set schedule rather than regularly.**

Cybersecurity is a shared responsibility of everyone. By staying alert, following good online practices, and looking out for new cyber risks, we can make the online world safer for ourselves and our communities. One click can threaten security, but one second of caution can save critical information and save a lot of money. Together, awareness and appropriate digital activity are our best weapons against cybercrime.
